Honorary Vice Presidents

Our former Dakota Division Directors and Vice Directors retired at the end of the January board meeting. Both were elected to the title of Honorary Vice President.

Jay Bellows, K0QB, served 22 years on the board and continues to serve as International Amateur Radio Union (IARU) Region 2 (The Americas) Treasurer.

Greg Widin, K0GW, served 12 years on the board and continues to serve as Chairman of the Logbook Of The World Committee (LOTW).

Board Elections

CEO

Chief Executive Officer Dr. Howard Michel's contract was not renewed. By secret ballot, 7 directors voted to retain him and 9 directors voted to dismiss him.

I voted to retain Dr. Michel because I thought he was making improvements in day-to-day operations of our non-profit organization that has about 80 employees and about a 15 million dollar annual operating budget.

My fellow board members have a considerable challenge to find our 3rd CEO in as many years. A search committee has been formed to hire a new CEO with experience running a non-profit organization, enthusiasm for amateur radio, doesn't mind New England weather and possibly paying higher state income taxes than previously used to. The new job posting is available on arrl.org.

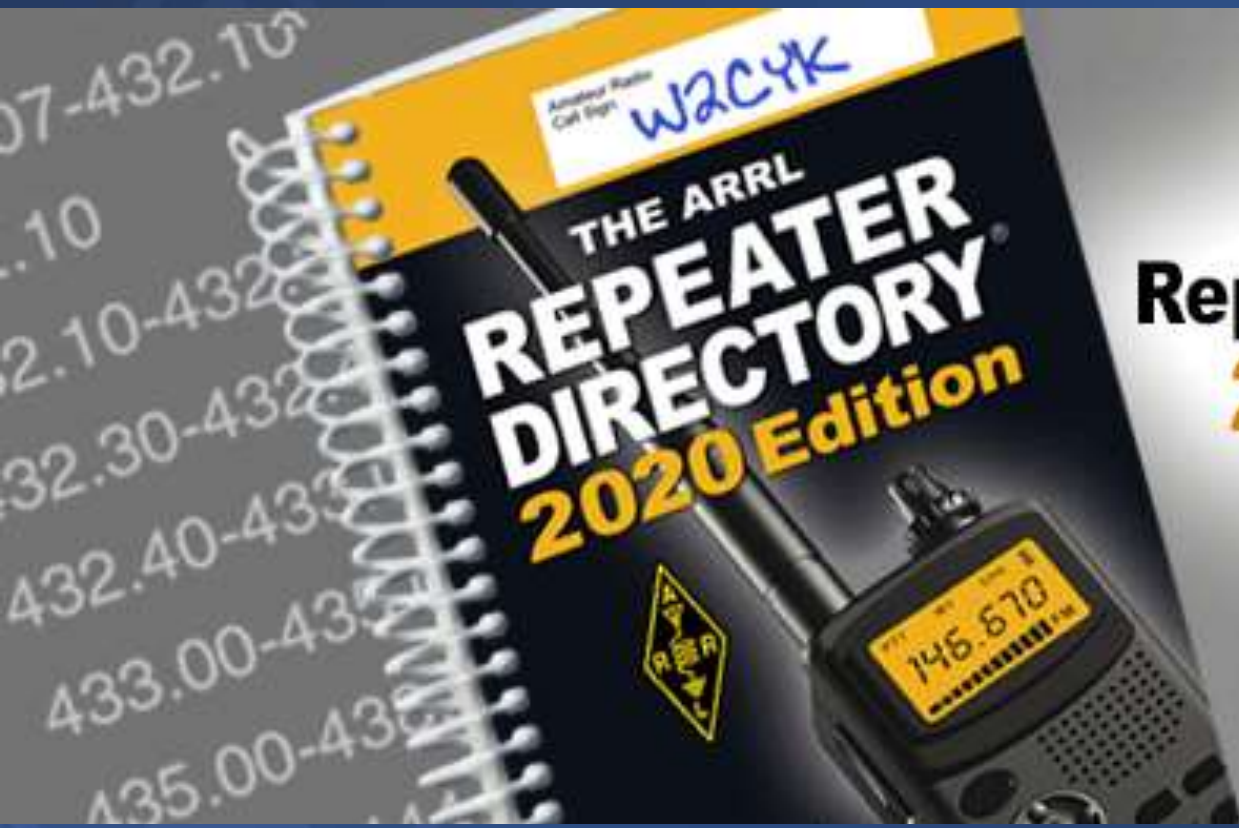
